During her practice she was a member of (COPARMEX) - The Mexican Confederation of Employers and became a representative for this organization at the National Housing Committees before the Institute of the National Housing Fund for workers (INFONAVIT) and the National Housing Commission (CONAVI) until 2009.

Having previously been involved in sustainability projects and water protection in Coahuila, Mexico she moved to the Netherlands to learn more about organic farming and distribution. Milène worked for 5 years and was responsible of quality surveillance and distribution of organic products in the Nord-Holland Province.

In 2014 she was offered the position of project manager for the "Mexico and United Kingdom Dual Year 2015" at the MexCC where she became the General Manager and was appointed Director in 2015.
